Turn South onto 92nd St.

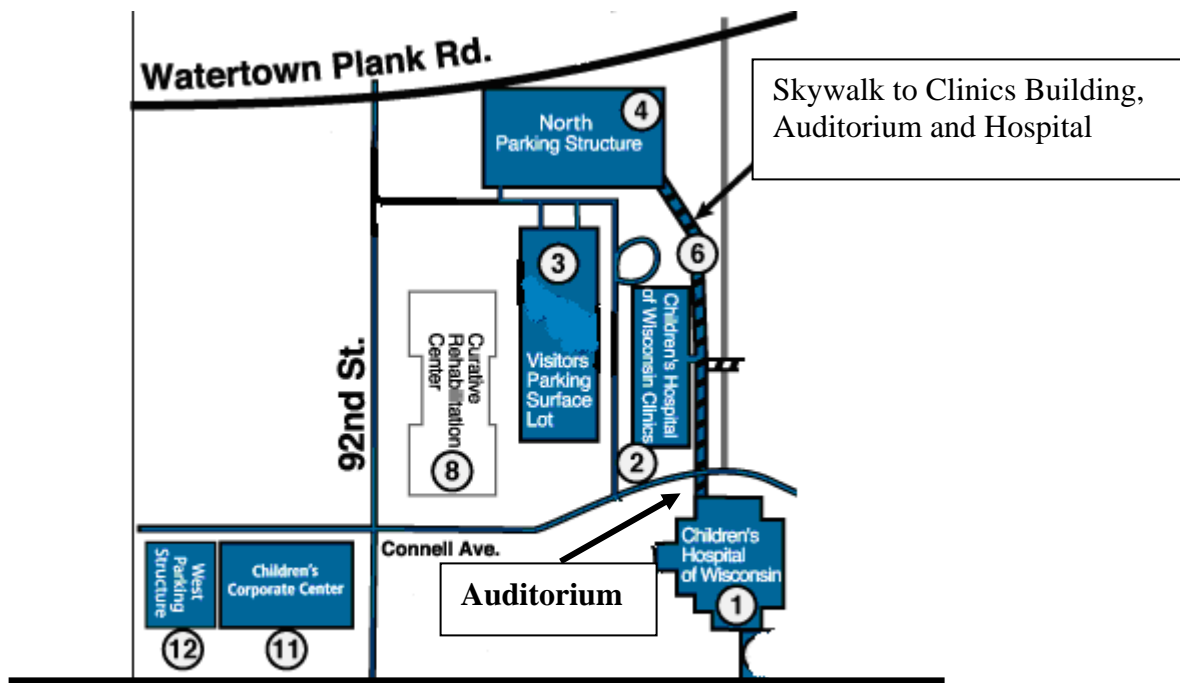
OR
